

Bible Verse: John 2:11 “What Jesus did here in Cana of Galilee was the first of the signs through which he revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him.”

Our story last week was about Jesus gathering special followers, disciples, to walk with him and learn from him, and to help him spread the message of the Son of God.

The disciples witness many miracles.
The story of the first miracle comes from the Gospel of John.

As this Gospel story begins, Jesus and His mother Mary and His disciples have been invited to a wedding at a place called Cana.

Everyone seems to be enjoying the wedding feast. There is lots of good food to eat and good wine and water to drink.

The wedding guests stay for a long time, enjoying the party.

Jesus’ mother discovers that the hosts are running out of wine.

Jesus’ mother tells the hosts that Jesus can help them. She says they should do whatever Jesus tells them to.

Jesus isn’t really prepared for this, but he does want to help his mother and her friends.

So, Jesus tells the hosts to fill some large containers with water.

When they are filled up, Jesus tells them to taste the water. And guess what? The water had changed into wine.

The guests even said that the new wine was better than the wine they had before. Jesus had changed regular water into great wine!

We know that Jesus came into the world to change the world. He could change water into wine, but he also can change hate into love and enemies into friends, even now.

Wonder Question: If Jesus were alive today, what might you ask him to “change”?
