



**Epiphany Parish – Walpole, Massachusetts**  
**COVID-19 Re-Gathering Information AMENDMENT 10/3/20**  
**Pumpkin Patch**

- Everyone who visits or works in the Pumpkin Patch must wear a mask.
- All volunteers are required to practice social distancing of 6 feet or more from people who are not members of their household.
- Signs will be posted to ask all guests to practice social distancing of 6 feet or more from people who are not members of their household.
- All Pumpkin Patch Volunteers will read and sign the ‘Epiphany Parish COVID-19 Pumpkin Patch Volunteer Covenant’ stating that they agree to follow all set health and safety procedures.
- There is a sign-in sheet inside the driveway side door. Anyone who enters the parish building must sign in and provide their:
  - name,
  - phone number, and
  - entry and exit times.
- Sign-in sheets will be kept in the parish office for 2 months and will be shared with appropriate health officials as required.
- Social distancing in the building must be observed. There may be no more than one visitor in the office at any one time or two people in the vestry room at any one time.
- Masks must be worn inside the building and in the Pumpkin Patch.
- Volunteers will not work if they are experiencing new onset symptoms of COVID-19 (fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea) or have had contact with anyone with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
- Hand sanitizer, disposable masks, gloves, and approved cleaning wipes will be available for volunteer and guest use.
- Contactless Payment options will be provided
- All tables, chairs, and any other high-touch surfaces must be wiped down at the beginning and end of each shift.
- All electronic devices must be wiped down after each use with the provided wipes.
- No more than 50 people will be allowed in the patch at any time.
- Volunteers will monitor attendance and will ask people to wait in line if the maximum capacity has been reached.
