Our job as Christians is to let that Light of Love shine inside of us so brightly that others can see the Light of God through us.

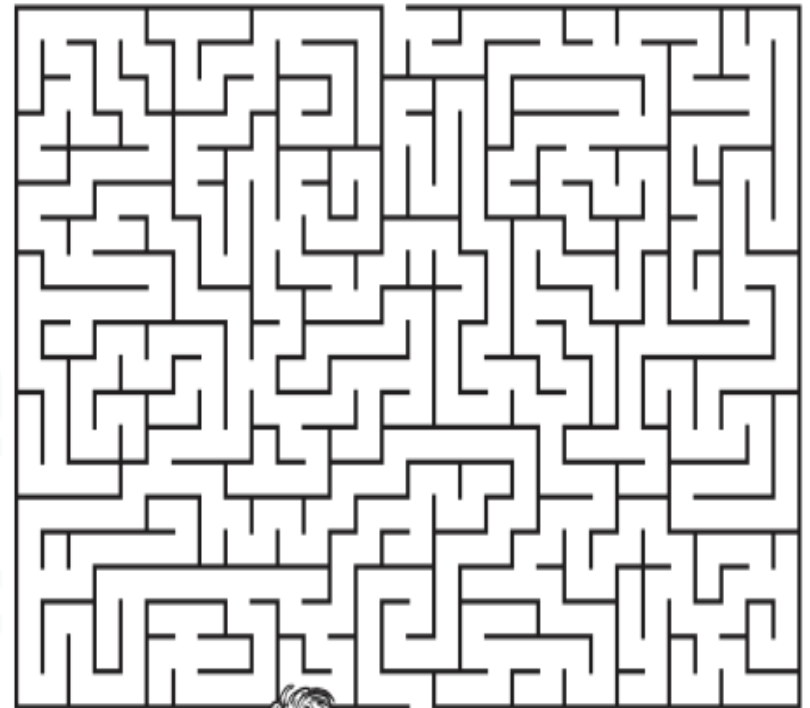
We shine God's light in the good things we say and do. We try to reflect the Holy Spirit out there, in the world.
